# **2022.01 Enact Federal Legislation to Reduce Food Loss and Waste**

Submitted by Alberta Mackenzie Provincial Council, the resolution .."urges the federal government to enact legislation to reduce food loss and waste in Canada's agri-food, industrial, commercial and institutional sectors."

## Faith Service and Social Justice

On August 24, 2022 the national board advised the standing committees will be reduced to three, Faith, Service and Social Justice

Currently **CL** responsibilities include: dignity and rights of persons; social and economic justice: refugees, immigration and citizenship: Development and Peace and developing countries. The first two fall under **social justice** and the final three under **service**. The guidelines will assist councils to transition to the new structure.
