In keeping with the **loneliness theme,** I am including a copy of a report on the Seniors Summit I participated in. We were presented with the following topic: What are the Main Issues Facing Seniors. Loneliness was on the top of the list. I hope you can take the time to read the report I am including and look forward to your thoughts and concerns on this subject.

At the national executive/board meeting held November 1 and 2, it was agreed that the League would partner with Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA) to support the Pietra Bhaven (House of Mercy) Project. Pietra Bhaven, located in Kerala, India, is a Christian home for more than 60 women with intellectual disabilities. Currently, Pietra Bhaven has an open well in need of repair. It is vital to have suitable wells to keep water clean and drinkable for daily use.

As this is the second year focus for **Care for Our Common Home**, all councils are asked to take part in this project, with a need for a drinking water well.

All members/parishes are asked to please report donations to myself who will in turn provide that total to our provincial community life chair.

Colleen Perry, our provincial president will inform the national community life chairperson on the total amount donated from Ontario by August 1,2020.
